30 August 2017, Berlin – FRIENDS WITH BOOKS: ART BOOK FAIR BERLIN 2017 takes place on the weekend of **22–24 September, 2017**, at **Hamburger Bahnhof – Museum für Gegenwart – Berlin** as Europe's premier event for contemporary artists' books and periodicals by artists and art publishers. Featuring **160+ international participants** and a series of public programmes: discussions, readings, presentations, performances, and art installations that explore the perimeters of today's art publishing. Admission is free.
